Whether you are targeting responsible investment to align with stakeholder values, mitigate risk or comply with regulation, you should choose a solution with real integrity and impact.

At Russell Investments, we consider true responsible investing as a long-term approach that accounts for a wide range of complex environmental, social and governance (ESG) factors.

We believe that responsible investing and performance can be complementary. Our responsible investment solutions aim to capture the right exposure without jeopardising returns.

Invest in what matters to you with a team that deploys a robust, integrated process and draws on a deep knowledge of how ESG factors impact security returns. Ensure your investments are not unknowingly exposed to the risk of ESG factors such as climate change, undesired controversial products and services, political upheaval or governance issues that can lead to poor outcomes over the long term.



Proactively invest in companies with good governance, transparency and a focus on sustainability.



Aiming to generate consistent returns through an investment portfolio designed with your organisation's risk profile in mind.



Provide key stakeholders (including shareholders, customers, unions, lobby groups, and funding bodies) with clear and comprehensive reports, demonstrating where your investments have resulted in positive sustainable practices and solutions.

Innovation in action

- Developed and implemented the 'material ESG score', an ESG scoring methodology that focuses on the issues that are material to a company and their profitability based on their industry. The score is informed by metrics identified by the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (SASB).

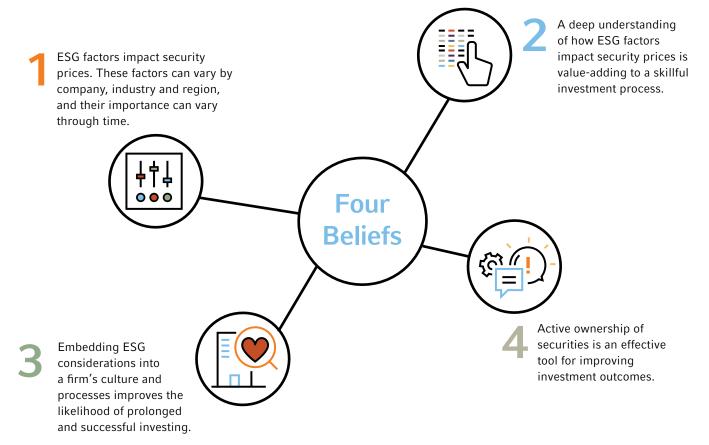
Russell Investments achieves "A / A+" in PRI 2020 Assessment.

Russell Investments recorded an A+ or A for all 10 categories assessed in the United Nations-supported Principles for Responsible Investment (PRI) annual report. This positive assessment captures individual asset classes including: fixed income, private equity, property and infrastructure. The consistent high performance across all asset classes demonstrates the strength of our integrated investment approach.

Launched in April 2006, the PRI is an investor initiative developed in partnership with the United Nations Environment Program Finance Initiative and the United Nations Global Compact. The six guiding principles of the PRI provide global best practices that challenge investors to acknowledge ESG issues.

As a global investment solutions provider, we believe that transparency and investing responsibly can help deliver attractive investment returns and meet client objectives in the long-term.

To reflect this, we have developed a set of four beliefs upon which our responsible investing practice is founded. These beliefs are as follows.



In addition to the beliefs we have formal policies related to responsible investing, climate and sustainability risks:

Russell Investments' policy is to incorporate *responsible investing* into our investment manager evaluation process, our portfolio management, our advisory services, and through implementing proprietary solutions as desired by clients. (2017)

Russell Investments' policy is to research, measure, report and consider *climate-change risk and opportunities* as integral parts of our investing practice, our active ownership, and our business operations. Our measures, reported metrics, and consideration of climate risk and opportunities are integrated into

our sub-advisor research and selection, portfolio management, advice, proxy voting and shareholder engagement, and day-to-day business. (2020)

Russell Investments' policy is to integrate *sustainability risks* in our investment solutions by identifying, evaluating and managing relevant risks in our investment manager review process, portfolio management and through implementing proprietary solutions. We believe *sustainability risks* are most relevant to investment outcomes when they exhibit *financial materiality*, and, like all investment risks, are incorporated by balancing *expected risk* with *expected reward*. In managing investment solutions, we consider financially-material sustainability risks

in the context of expected rewards, using a blend of inputs from sources including, but not limited to, investment managers, third-party data sources and Russell Investments propriety analysis. Furthermore, we incorporate bespoke sustainability risks based on clients' requirements for customised mandates. As well, we seek to collaborate with our advisory clients to consider, monitor and manage sustainability risk priorities in their portfolios. (2021)

Manager

We research and rank thousands of investment products on their ability to add meaningful value to portfolios. The ESG disaggregated rank, like all disaggregated ranks, contributes to the overall manager rank.

Portfolio construction

We only select actively managed investment products with the highest overall ranks. As well, our products may include ESG-related themes.

Sustainability risk management

Our portfolio manager team has developed a Sustainability Risks Policy and Practice to complement and enhance our portfolio and risk management practices.

Strategy development

Our researchers continually develop and refine ESGrelated strategies such as, Decarbonisation 2.0, impact investing and ESG-themed solutions.

Metrics and reporting

Our internal reporting and oversight includes multiple industry-standard metrics, along with our own proprietary metrics such as the Material ESG Score. To continually expand our metrics and reporting, we partner with multiple data providers including, Sustainalytics, MSCI, SASB, Carbonne 4, and CDP.

Proxy voting

We aim to improve the longterm investment outcomes of assets through active ownership, focusing intensely on four core principles: transparency, accountability, independence and long-term value.

Solutions developed for clients include:

Thematic investment funds

We have developed strategies to commonly identified investor themes such as decarbonisation, systematic ESG direct investing and impact investing which integrate ESG factors further into the investment process. Funds can be directly accessed or developed to meet our clients' specific requirements.

Russell Investments Australian Responsible Investment FTF (RARI)

This ETF tracks the performance of a custom-built, smart-beta index, predominantly invested in Australian shares and trusts listed on the ASX. The index negatively screens for companies that have a significant involvement in a range of activities deemed inconsistent with widely recognised responsible investment objectives, such as tobacco and armaments. The index is then weighted to companies that demonstrate positive ESG characteristics.

Russell Investments Low Carbon Australian Shares Fund

The Fund is designed to provide access to a broad range of Australian shares, with a reduced exposure to carbon emissions and fossil fuel reserves by 35% and 30% respectively compared to its benchmark. The Fund goes beyond carbon reduction, aiming to provide an increased exposure to the most sustainable companies by positively tilting the portfolio towards stocks with higher than average material ESG scores.

Russell Investments Low Carbon Global Shares Fund

The Fund helps investors to manage climate change risk and the transition to a low carbon economy using our proprietary decarbonisation investment strategy. The Fund provides access to a broad range of global shares in developed and emerging markets, with a 50% reduced exposure to carbon emissions and fossil fuel reserves compared to its benchmark. The Fund goes beyond carbon reduction to positively support companies with a green energy agenda and a higher than average material ESG score.

Russell Investments Sustainable Global Shares ex Fossil Fuels Fund

The Fund goes beyond carbon reduction. It excludes companies with fossil fuel reserves, as well as companies with a significant involvement in fossil fuel activities. Designed to help investors manage climate change risk, the Fund provides access to a broad range of global shares in developed and emerging markets, with a 60% reduced exposure to carbon emissions compared to its benchmark.

Doing well while doing good

Development of portfolios with more optimal responsible investing exposure. This includes portfolios which incorporate allocations to higher material ESG scores or to impact investing.

Material ESG scores

Using our proprietary material ESG score we positively tilt portfolios towards securities with higher material ESG scores, ensuring an industry appropriate comparison.

Impact Investing

Impact investing involves building bespoke portfolios to generate both a positive societal and environment impact, whilst aiming to generate financial returns. Examples include provision of affordable healthcare, renewable energy/climate change mitigation and food security. We design, construct and manage impact portfolios for large institutional clients, particularly in private market mandates.

ESG-themed strategies

If you are seeking a specific portfolio outcome, our team can work with you to implement focused investment strategies, such as decarbonisation or social capital, to pursue your desired objective.

Managing exclusions

We aim to ensure that required and requested portfolio exclusions are managed to minimise unintended exposures while still aligning to investment objectives.
