July 2024 RUSSELL INVESTMENTS SHORT TERM INCOME POOL

We've reallocated capital from a global credit factor strategy to the underlying third-party managers in **Russell Investments Short Term Income Pool** (the "Fund") as part of an ongoing effort to ensure the Funds are exposed to the best ideas from our portfolio management and manager research teams.

At Russell Investments Canada Limited (Russell Investments), we are committed to providing high-conviction investment solutions utilizing a selection of the world's leading investment managers to help Canadians pursue their desired investment outcomes.

We have eliminated the **Russell Investments Global Credit Factor Strategy** ("Credit Factors") and reallocated the capital to existing sub-advisers **Canso Investment Counsel Ltd.** and **Leith Wheeler Investment Counsel Ltd.**

Overall investment objectives, risk parameters, and the Funds' characteristics will not materially change as a result of these changes. Russell Investments believes these changes will support the excess return potential of the Fund.

Fund change details

We have added to the weightings of the sub-advisers:

- Canso Investment Counsel Ltd.
- Leith Wheeler Investment Counsel Ltd.

We have removed the weighting to:

Russell Investments - Credit Factors

Change rationale

By removing the Credit Factor Strategy in the Fund, Russell Investments is reducing off benchmark risk during a period where we may continue to see divergent paths across global markets. Although the Fund will be less globally diversified, the removal of this strategy and allocation to existing sub-advisers is expected to result in similar long-term total returns with reduced tracking error.
