## Fund objective

To provide a total return, before costs and tax, higher than the S&P/NZX 50 Index (gross and including imputation credits) over the long term (3 years plus).

## Fund update

Stock selection within the industrials space contributed positively to performance; notably underweights to Skellerup and Auckland International Airport. A material underweight to property trusts also added value, including an underweight to Goodman Property Trust. Stock selection amongst financials added further value over the period. In contrast, stock selection within the consumer staples sector detracted from overall performance, including an underweight to a2 Milk Company. Stock selection within the consumer discretionary space also weighed on returns; notably an overweight to KMD Brands. Meanwhile, the Fund's factor positioning strategy performed in line with the benchmark in January.

The ESG Risk Score is the weighted average of the Sustainalytics' Risk Score for companies in the portfolio. The Sustainalytics' Risk Score focuses on ESG issues that are financially material to the company and incorporates both risk exposure and issue management. The scores range from 0 to 100 where higher scores imply higher ESG risk. The Carbon Footprint is the Weighted Average Carbon Intensity which we define as relative carbon emissions as the weighted average of portfolio companies' Scope 1 & 2 GHG emissions divided by revenue (CO<sub>2</sub>e/\$1M revenue USD). Tobacco exposure is defined as the weight of securities in the portfolio classified as being in the GICS tobacco subindustry.
