### Searching beyond the standard

Our investment approach strives to go beyond standard exclusions to identify asset characteristics that are most relevant to the individual investment and the overall portfolio. The focus is on exposures that are sustainable as well as material to your organization's investment goals. This allows clients to both remove unwanted characteristics and proactively support those organizations who positively contribute to research, innovation and leading best practices.

For example, within our decarbonization strategy, we don't just remove all oil and gas companies based on their carbon footprint, but look deeper to understand how these companies support renewable energy. Only then, by understanding the complete picture, do we determine the value of the investment.

### Actively looking to the future

As the focus of sustainability best practice shifts over time, we stay committed to adapting our funds to suit the changing global landscape. You can be sure your capital remains invested in the latest sustainable strategies, without continually changing funds.

#### Innovation in action

- Undertaking research and development to create a new framework that incorporates water risk data into our investment process.
- The implementation of our proprietary decarbonization strategy to both global asset allocations and domestic markets.
- Developed and implemented the 'material ESG score', an ESG scoring methodology that focuses on the issues that are material to a company and their profitability based on their industry. The score is informed by metrics identified by the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (SASB).


# Russell Investments achieved "A / A+" in PRI 2019 Assessment.

Russell Investments recorded an A+ or A for all 10 categories assessed in the United Nations-supported Principles for Responsible Investment (PRI) annual report. This positive assessment captures individual asset classes including: fixed income, private equity, property and infrastructure. The consistent high performance across all asset classes demonstrates the strength of our integrated investment approach.

Launched in April 2006, the PRI is an investor initiative developed in partnership with the United Nations Environment Program Finance Initiative and the United Nations Global Compact. The six guiding principles of the PRI provide global best practices that challenge investors to acknowledge ESG issues.

At Russell Investments, we believe that a sound awareness of ESG factors and a robust process can help deliver strong investment returns and meet objectives over the long term.

To reflect this, we have developed a set of four beliefs upon which our responsible investing practice is founded. These beliefs are as follows:

# Portfolio management process

We research and rank thousands of investment managers on their ability to add value to portfolios. All manager reviews include an assessment of how ESG considerations are incorporated within the investment managers' policy, process, awareness and offering.

We also calculate our funds' ESG and carbon metrics for use by our analysts and portfolio managers.



### Insights & research

Our research actively looks towards the future. To understand how best to add long-term value for clients, we evaluate manager products both on an individual basis and an industry basis. We advocate for best practices in specialized products such as low-carbon portfolios, governance-driven strategies, green bonds and impact investing.

This helps to continually improve our own product offerings in these areas and offer "best-in-class" strategies.



# Active ownership & engagement

Russell Investments believes voting is a part of a share's value-creation process. We aim to improve the longterm investment outcomes of assets through our active stewardship and voting policy by promoting four core principles: transparency, accountability, independence and longterm value. As stewards, we monitor the effectiveness of company management on an ongoing basis. As share owners, we aim to exert influence on corporate governance, social and environmental practices through our votes.

# Responsible investment solutions for clients

#### Thematic investment funds

We have developed strategies to commonly identified investor themes such as decarbonization, systematic ESG direct investing and impact investing which integrate ESG factors further into the investment process. Funds can be directly accessed or developed to meet our clients' specific requirements.

An example of this is:

#### Russell Investments decarbonization strategy

The strategy helps investors to manage climate change risk and the transition to a low-carbon economy, using our proprietary decarbonization investment strategy. It provides access to a broad range of global shares, in developed and emerging markets, with a 50% reduced exposure to carbon emissions and fossil fuel reserves compared to its benchmark. The strategy goes beyond carbon reduction alone to positively support companies with a green energy agenda. This strategy can be applied to a passive, factor-based or active equity implementation.

We work with many of our institutional clients around the world to capture their specific responsible investment requirements within their investment portfolios. A minimum investment level is required, and solutions are custom built specifically for your organization.

### Positive investment

Development of portfolios with more focus on responsible investing, such as tilting to stocks with higher material ESG scores or impact investing.

#### Material ESG scores

Using our proprietary material ESG score we positively tilt portfolios towards securities with higher material ESG scores, seeking to ensure an industry appropriate comparison.

#### Impact Investing

Impact investing involves building bespoke portfolios to generate both a positive societal and environment impact, while seeking to generate financial returns. Examples include provision of affordable healthcare, renewable energy/climate change mitigation and food security. We design, construct and manage impact portfolios for large institutional clients, particularly in private market mandates.

# Thematic strategies

If you are seeking a specific portfolio outcome, our team can work with you to design, construct and manage specific investment strategies such as decarbonization or social capital to achieve your desired objectives.

Application of negative screens and exclusions to portfolios according to your objectives, e.g. removal of companies involved in manufacture and/or production of weapons, tobacco, cluster ammunitions, gambling and fossil fuels.
